J. "Bruce" Mordaunt, 88, of Fogelsville, passed away January 6, 2021 after a valiant fight with COVID-19 at St. Luke's Hospital, Allentown. He was the beloved husband of Rosemarie (Santee) Mordaunt to whom he was married for 54 years in September. He was born on October 20, 1932 in Allentown to the late Harvey and Minna (Schubert) Mordaunt. He served in the U. S. Army Security Agency in Kyota, Japan. Bruce graduated from Lafayette College and worked for many years at Bethlehem Steel until his retirement. After retiring, he operated the Carvel Ice Cream store in the Trexlertown Mall. At an early age, he was interested in cars, and dreamt of restoring a Lincoln Continental, a dream never fulfilled. Bruce loved the Lehigh Valley and worked to preserve it. He was a president of the Northwestern Lehigh Citizens Coalition which opposed the construction of the Trexler Dam across the Jordan River. Bruce was one of the founding members of the "Hivel und Dahl Society" to restore the Schubert-Grabel Log Cabin, now part of the National Register of Historic Places. He was a member of the Schwenkfelder Exile Society and Weisenberg Lutheran Church. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends.
