Jacqueline "Jackie" Perry (nee Wehrhagen), 83, of Allentown, Pennsylvania, passed away on August 30, 2023, at home surrounded by her family. She was born in a farmhouse in Alburtis, Pennsylvania, to John and Irene Wehrhagen on March 5, 1940. She grew up in Wescosville, Pennsylvania graduating from Emmaus High School in 1958.

She loved to dance the jitterbug and frequented Dick Clark's American Bandstand in Philadelphia in the late 1950's. She loved sports cars and racing corvettes with her husband at local hill climbs.
