Once a year in mid August you'd know where to find him, every night at the Kutztown Fair. He loved country music with favorites such as George Jones, Conway Twitty, George Strait and Loretta Lynn, along with many years of following Twitty Fever/Rehrig Brother wherever they would be, or just finding a local church picnic or summertime music in the park. And at home it was the CWTAP Uncle Jeffery channel.

He is survived by his children, Kyle and fiancé, Beth Kramer, Karen Henninger, Kandy Solt, Kina Leiby, Kurt and wife Kathy, and Kevin and wife Heather; 14 grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; and 1 great-great grandson; He was predeceased by his daughter, Kathy Keller; son-in-law Crail Keller, granddaughter Michele Solt and siblings; Warren, Pauline, Arlene, Betty and Kermit.
